Clarification on NREMT exams RE:

MAKE UP DATES for Aug and Sept 2015 CE

In System memo #355 we rolled out how currently licensed paramedics could attend portions of the Paramedic class seminar hours to complete required topics and hours to meet the National Registry of EMTs (NREMT) Refresher Course prior to voluntarily taking the NREMT written and practical exams.

This opportunity will be offered again next year.

## **Clarification re: NREMT exams:**

NREMT WRITTEN EXAMS are computer adaptive and taken at testing centers. They are self-scheduled by the paramedic at a date and time of their choosing after receiving approval to test by Dr. Ortinau, applying on-line to the NREMT, and receiving an authorization to test message with a PIN number from the NREMT. The Paramedic class Seminar morning sessions are designed to prepare attendees for the NREMT written exam. The seminar schedule is posted to the System website: www.nwcemss.org.

NREMT PRACTICAL EXAMS are taken at NCH and will be held on June 27 and July 18 as explained in System memo 355. The Paramedic class Seminar afternoon labs are designed to prepare attendees for the NREMT practical exam.

## MAKE UP CLASSES FOR NWC EMSS CE

Paramedics who may have missed System CE this past year are encouraged to complete the Credit Question packets for that class. However, they may also make them up by attending paramedic class seminar hours covering those topics (didactic in the morning; labs in the afternoon).

Two CE classes could not be made up by completing Credit Question Packets as they involved patient scenarios with practical skill performance. See below how they can be made up by attending paramedic class seminar labs:
