The data is narrowed and Taylor explains that is a good benchmark to shoot for, but does not accurately reflect the overall arrest data. Some of the data points in the reporting are not even given so there is some skewed data

CPR Induced Consciousness	 The idea is that the patient is mimicking consciousness due to high-quality CPR. Is there any data out there? Glendenning has a contact in Nebraska. Pt was talking to the doctor and begging him to stop CPR. Still need to treat the underlying issue, i.e. V-Fib A lot more research and data needed before addressing it as a system
